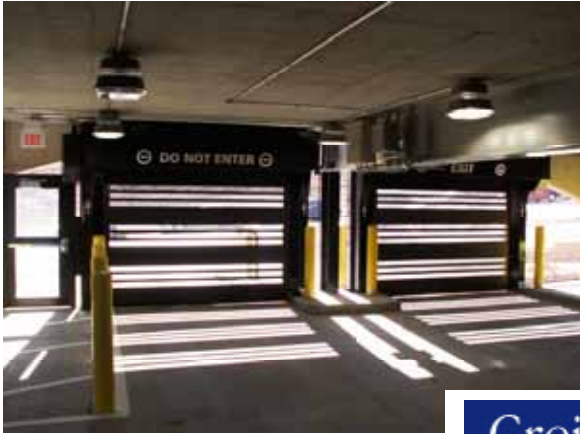

Creighton University Solves Two Problems with RapidRoll® 3000 Slatted Aluminum Doors



Creighton University in Omaha Nebraska is a Jesuit university founded in 1878. With more than 50 undergraduate programs and over 20 graduate programs serving more than 6500 students, the school is always aware of the importance of maintaining a safe environment for the students and the faculty.

When two new parking structures were built, security was a primary concern of the administration. It was important to them that transients not be able to enter and occupy the structures. Also, because the structures had no power ventilation, the high performance doors chosen had to provide sufficient airflow to maintain air quality at a safe level.

The solution was found in Albany Door Systems Model 3000 aluminum slatted door. Because the door is aluminum, a pedestrian can't push their way through the doors as they could with a fabric door. For further security, card readers were integrated into the doors' control systems so the structure can be entered only with a school issued I.D. The speed with which the doors opened and closed added to the security, as it made it difficult for someone to enter the structure when a vehicle entered or exited.

The ventilation concern was solved by supplying the doors with perforated slats.

Creighton installed ten Model 3000 Anodized black doors with perforated aluminum slats—a true testimonial to the quality of the doors.
